At the World Triathlon Powerman MD Duathlon Championship, all athletes should comply with the approved National Federation uniform colour/format. The uniform must follow World Triathlon uniform rules.

1.9. TIMING CHIP

Distribution: Timing chips will be distributed at check-in on race day. Elite will have the timing chips in the race packages.

Collection: Timing chips will be collected at check-out when you leave the transition area.

Loss during the race: If you lose your timing chip during the race, please inform the event staff in the transition area so that the timing providers can do their best to replace the chip.

Withdrawal: If you do not participate in the race or withdraw from the race, please return the timing chip to a staff member at the event information booth for withdrawals or, if you are unable to reach this location, to any event staff member. If possible, only give the chip to an official event staff member and not to a volunteer. Lost timing chips: If your timing chip is not returned or is lost, you will be charged €50 for a replacement.


1.15. WEATHER

Weather in April in Alsdorf, North Rhine-Westphalia, Germany

The daily maximum temperatures *increase* by 4 °C from 12 °C to 16 °C and rarely fall below 6 °C or rarely exceed 23 °C.

The daily minimum temperatures *increase by 3 °C* from 4 °C to 7 °C and rarely fall below -1 °C or rarely exceed 11 °C.

By comparison, on 4 August, the hottest day of the year, temperatures in Alsdorf usually range from 14 $^{\circ}$ C to 23 $^{\circ}$ C, while on 8 February, the coldest day of the year, they range from 0 $^{\circ}$ C to 5 $^{\circ}$ C.








2.2. COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

There is no familiarisation.

Be careful it not allowed to ride bikes on the roads L240 and on the 57n. They can only use when they are closed for the race.

2.3. ATHLETE'S LOUNGE

The Elite Athlete Lounge is located on the first floor of the Alsdorf Stadthalle.

The bag drop of is in the city hall (Annastraße 2-6, 52477 Alsdorf), there are also toilets.

A recovery area is behind the finish, showers are in the Hallenbad Alsdorf.

2.4. RACE PACKAGE

The **Elite** Race pack will distributed after the briefing.

Age-Group Race pack pick up is located at the Absolute Teamsport, Bahnhofstraße 56, Alsdorf - see google map AG race pack: Body decals: 2x for both forearms and 1x for AG category at back of calf + 1x Bib number + stickers (3x helmets + 1x bike saddle + 1x for bags to be left at the bag drop-off) + accreditation + registration gift

2.5. DOPING CONTROL

The doping control will be located in the city hall. Doping tests will be conducted according to NADA rules. The athletes must carry their identification to the doping control facilities.

Anti-Doping Rules, like Competition rules, are sport rules governing the conditions under which sport is played. Athletes and other persons involved in the event accept these rules as a precondition to compete. All athletes shall be subject to Competition Testing by the World Triathlon, the Athlete's National Federation, Anti-Doping Organizations or any other organization promoting Events in triathlon.

**All athletes must ensure they carry their official identification (Photo ID) **

If you are selected for Doping Control, someone will approach you to notify you. You may be asked to go for Doping Control even before the race, for example, after picking up your Registration pack or when you check in your bicycle in the Transition Area. The Doping Control Chaperone and/or Officer will explain the procedure to you, but you need to be aware that you have certain rights and responsibilities.

You have the right to:

- a) Appoint a representative of your choice to accompany you to Doping Control.
- b) Request the services of an interpreter in case you do not have a good command of English (if required).
- c) Request additional information about the Doping Control procedure.
- d) Request a delay in reporting to the Doping Control Station for valid reasons. (These reasons may be to receive necessary medical care, locate a representative or fulfill a media commitment but you

must have the consent of, and be in full view of, the Doping Control Officer or Chaperone.)

- e) Request necessary modifications if you have a disability.
- f) Note any concerns with the Doping Control process on the Doping Control Form. g) Request part "B" of your sample be analysed to confirm a positive result.
- g) A fair hearing in compliance with the World Anti-Doping Code.

Your responsibilities include:

- a) Be aware of, and comply with, the World Anti-Doping Code and the TRI Anti-Doping Rules.
- b) Be aware of which substances are not allowed and are included in the Prohibited List.
- c) Comply with requirements for Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE). A TUE allows you to take a substance included in the Prohibited List, if that is the only option available to you and you meet specific requirements. There are strict rules governing TUEs, so it is best to check them before the event. As an Age-Group athlete, you may apply for a retroactive TUE but it is not guaranteed, so you may want to request one no later than 30 days prior to racing. If you want to apply for a TUE, please contact your National Anti-Doping Agency (NADO). If approved by your NADO, your TUE will be recognized by World Triathlon.
- d) After being notified for a doping test, to report to the Doping Control Station immediately or within the required time slot specified by the Doping Control Chaperone.
- e) Control your sample until it is sealed in the sample collection kit.
- f) Ensure the sealed sample collection kit is secure and identified.
- g) Ensure all documentation is accurate.

You must carry with you an ID/passport with photo when proceeding to the Doping Control Station. It is also a good idea to make sure that you have access to your National Federation manager's phone number so that you can let him/her know that you have been selected for Doping Control.




